Marin Bejerano, *Musicologist, Jazz Musician, Head of Jazz Keyboard at UM Frost School of Music* will speak about the Music of Miami, it's history and how it got here.

Laura Bracken, *Program Director at Miami Waterkeeper* will speak on 1,000 Eyes on the Water Training in observing, documenting, and writing about the conditions and quality of the waters around Miami.

This workshop trains teachers to support students in preparation and participation of the PIANO SLAM poetry and music competition.
